The Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, TreeVitalizeSM program is currently accepting applications throughout the state. Listed below is information on how to apply for trees or funding to buy and then plant trees.

(12 Metros Regions) Grant Round Closes on March 1, 2012

All municipalities located within the TreeVitalize Metros regions: Berks, Blair, Cambria, Centre, Cumberland, Dauphin, Erie, Lackawanna, Lancaster, Lebanon, Lehigh, Lycoming, Luzerne, Perry, Wyoming & York counties are eligible to apply for TreeVitalize funding. (Pittsburgh Region) Grant Round Closes on March 9, 2012

(Philadelphia Region) Grant Round Closes on

(All Other Regions) Grant Round Closes on March 15, 2012

Counties who are not located within a 'TreeVitalize Region' are eligible to apply for grant funding to plant trees through the Pennsylvania Urban & Community Forestry Council (PAUCFC). Limited funding is available for tree planting and other urban forestry related projects. Applications are due by March 15, 2012. TreeVitalize Streams:

TreeVitalize is offering \$1 per tree reimbursement opportunity to watershed groups, conservation groups and county conservation districts that have installed riparian buffer plantings. Funding is still available through the *TreeVitalize Riparian Buffer Reimbursement Program!* All counties are eligible for the reimbursement funding except Bucks, Chester, Delaware, Montgomery and Philadelphia Counties, which are eligible for funding through "TreeVitalize Watersheds".
