

## 2010 CONIFERS

**Douglas Fir** - Grows 6' in 9 yrs. Soft, short, green needles. This tree prefers full sun and well-drained soils. Beautiful Christmas tree which holds needles longer than others, picturesque ornamental & good windbreak. Needs good soil. (Size 10-18", \*\*2-2 transplants) Sold in bundles of 10.



**Hemlock** A graceful, pyramidal tree growing to 70' or more. Short, soft green needles provide a lacy, graceful effect. Plant in part shade or full sun. Does well in a variety of soils, but prefers moist areas, such as along streambanks. Great hedge or screen if protected from strong winds. ( Size 8-14", 2-2 seedlings – root pruned, heavy root stock) Bundles of 10

**Blue Spruce** – A handsome ornamental growing 75 – 100 ft. Short, stiff, sharp needles ranging in color from blue to green. Great screen or windbreak. Plant in full sun. (Size 6-10", 2-2 seedlings – root pruned, heavy root stock)

**White Pine** – Fast growing to a mature of 75- 100 ft. Long soft needles. Prefers moist, well-drained soils in sun. Also grows on dry rocky &/or wet areas. Susceptible to wind damage, salt & high pH. (Size 10-20", \*\*2-2 transplants) Sold in bundles of 10.

## 2010 HARDWOODS

**Sugar Maple** – a.k.a. Hard Maple. Known for its brilliant fall orange and yellow color and it's sap for maple syrup. A fast growing tree, to 75' with a wide spread. Prefers rich, well-drained soil in full to partial sun. (Size 12-18") Sold individually.





**Swamp White Oak** – Great tree for planting in wet areas along creeks and rivers reaching a mature height of 50-60 ft with equal spread. Acorns are a good food source for wildlife and are about 1” long and paired. Does not tolerate high pH very well, prefers slightly acidic soils. Sold individually

**Eastern Redbud** - A small flowering tree with rosy pinkish-purple flowers in early spring. This native PA tree has heart-shaped leaves and is very effective as a mass planting. Mature height is 20-30 ft. Size 3 yr seedlings, 10-24”.

**Black Chokeberry** – A close cousin of the blueberry, Chokeberry is known for its antioxidant properties if you can withstand its extreme tartness. But the real beauty lies in its small, compact shape with pretty white flowers, brilliant fall colors and purple/black berries. Mature height is 3-6 ft. A very adaptable shrub. Sold individually.

**Washington Hawthorn** A small flowering tree—25-30 ft. in height & spread—producing bright red-orange fruit in fall and winter. Very decorative tree for use as a specimen tree, screen, street planting, and naturalizing. Berries are eaten by birds. Fall leaf color is scarlet-orange. Size 3 yr seedlings, 12-18”.

**White Flowering Dogwood** - Prefers shade or partial sun, commonly found along tree lines in acidic, well drained soil and grows 20-30’. Showy clusters of white flowers up to 5” in early May and bright berries in fall. (Size 12-18”)
