BAR HARBOR JUNIDER*

*AVAILABLE IN INDIVIDUAL POTS ONLY

<u>Description</u>: Commonly known as creeping juniper. Fast growing, evergreen shrub with blue-green foliage turning red-purple in winter. Versatile ground cover provides excellent use for rock gardens, foundations, retaining wall edges or on slopes for erosion control.

Mature Height: 1'
Mature Spread: 6-8'

Growth Rate: Slow - Medium

<u>Growing Conditions</u>: Adaptable to various soil types but prefers dry, sandy, well-drained soils. Full sun. Tolerant of deer, drought, erosion, dry soil and shallow, rocky soil. Intolerant of wet soils.



DOUGLAS FIR

<u>Description</u>: Tall, pyramidal conifer with flat, dark green, fragrant needles. As tree matures, green cones turn to grey and dark brown-red bark turns to thick, brown bark. This hardy, sturdy, easy to grow species is

ideal for a windbreak, ornamental tree or wildlife natural areas.

Mature Height: 40-80'
Mature Spread: 15-25'
Growth Rate: Medium

Growing Conditions: Prefers moist, well-drained soil. Partial to full

sun. Intolerant of heavy, wet, clay soil. Tolerant of drought.



EASTERN RED CEDAR

Description: Aromatic dark, shiny, green conifer. Berry-like cones turn from green to blue. Versatile, adaptable and easily transplanted. Often used for windbreaks, wildlife natural areas and privacy screens.

Mature Height: 40-50'
Mature Spread: 8-20'
Growth Rate: Medium

Growing Conditions: Adaptable to various soil types. Prefers full

sun. Tolerant of heat, drought and road salt.



EASTERN WHITE PINE

<u>Description:</u> Hardy, long-lived conifer with feathery blue-green needles, open canopy and straight trunk. Excellent ornamental tree that can be planted

singularly as a landscaping focal point, in groups for naturalizing or in rows as a dense, colorful screen or windbreak. Fast growing and easily transplanted.

Mature Height: 50-80' Mature Spread: 20-40' Growth Rate: Fast

<u>Growing Conditions</u>: Adaptable to various soil types and conditions but prefers moist, well-drained, sandy soils. Partial to full sun. Tolerant of rabbit and deer browse.



NORWAY SPRUCE

<u>Description</u>: Dense conifer covered with long cones, dark green needles and reddish bark.

Branches droop gracefully as tree matures, making it an attractive ornamental. Strong, fast growing tree makes it popular for windbreaks and reforesting

areas.

Mature Height: 40-60'
Mature Spread: 25-30'
Growth Rate: Fast

<u>Growing Conditions</u>: Adaptable to various soil types. Prefers moderate soil moisture and full sun. Tolerant of flooding and drought.



WHITE SPRUCE NATIVE

<u>Description</u>: Extremely hardy evergreen with short, stiff, light blue-green needles. Grows narrow, straight and tall. Excellent as an ornamental evergreen in rural areas or cities, wildlife natural areas, visual screen or windbreak.

Mature Height: 40-60'
Mature Spread: 10-20'
Growth Rate: Medium

<u>Growing Conditions</u>: Prefers moist, well-drained soils. Prefers full sun. Tolerant of drought, poorly drained and nutrient-deficient soils.

Growth Rates: Slow = Less than 12" per year

Medium = 12-24" per year

Fast = Over 24" per year

Sold individually in 3" x 3" x 9" pots

AMERICAN CHESTNUT

Description: Fast growing hybrid should produce rich, flavorful, edible nuts in 13-15 years. Although male and female flowers can be produced on the same tree, it's recommended to plant at least two trees for good pollination and nut production. Note: Hybrid is not guaranteed to be blight resistant.

Mature Height: 80-100' Growth Rate: Medium - Fast

Growing Conditions: Prefers well-drained soils in full





PAW PAW

Description: Large, drooping leaves and maroon flowers provides a tropical appearance to your backyard. Maroon, upside down flowers give way to large, sweet,

edible fruit, tasting like a mix of banana and mango. Typically bears fruit within 5-6 years. Plant at least two trees for fruit production to ensure cross-pollination.

Mature Height: 12-25' Mature Spread: 10-15'

Growth Rate: Medium

Growing Conditions: Prefers moist, rich, loamy soil.

Full sun.



HONEY LOCUST

Description: Feathery, yellow-green leaves. Twisted seed pods change from green to maroon-brown as they mature. Popular species for shade, urban areas and natural wildlife areas.

Mature Height: 30-70' Mature Spread: 30-70'

Growth Rate: Fast

Growing Conditions: Prefers moist, welldrained soils in full sun. Tolerant of wide range of soils, heat, drought and road salt.





REDOAK

Description: Fast growing oak with leaves turning deep red in autumn. Hardy and dense foliage makes it excellent for a shade or street

tree. Easily transplanted.

Mature Height: 60-75' Mature Spread: 60-75'

Growth Rate: Fast

Growing Conditions: Prefers moist, well-drained, acidic soils. Partial to full sun. Tolerant of road salt, air pollution and compacted soil.





RED OSIER DOGWOOD

Description: Medium, ornamental shrub with dark green leaves turning red-purple in fall. Tiny, fragrant white flowers appear in late spring. Stunning fall color,

attractive berries and vibrant red stems offers a focal point to any

winter landscape. Hardy, versatile shrub is a favorite among gardeners, landscapers and homeowners.

Mature Height: 6-10' Mature Spread: 8-12'

Growth Rate: Fast

Growing Conditions: Adaptable to various soil conditions. Prefers medium to wet, well-drained soils.



RIVER BIRCH

Description: Fast growing tree, popular for its ornamental peeling bark. Bright green leaves in spring

and summer turn to golden yellow in fall. Produces brown and green catkins in spring. Ideal as an ornamental tree in lawns, parks and commercial properties or along ponds, streams and

wetland areas. Easily transplanted.

Mature Height: 30-40' Mature Spread: 20-30'

Growth Rate: Medium - Fast

Growing Conditions: Prefers moist, well-drained soils. Partial to full sun. Tolerant of heat, deer, moderate

flooding and drought.





SUGAR MAPLE

Description: Dark green leaves change to spectacular yellow, orange and red in fall.

Provides excellent shade in summer, making it an ideal

ornamental tree for large, open landscapes.

Mature Height: 60-75' Mature Spread: 40-50' Growth Rate: Slow - Medium

Growing Conditions: Prefers moist, welldrained soils. Partial to full sun. Tolerant of shade. Intolerant of salt and urban pollution.



Description: Ornamental shrub known for its beautiful color during the winter. Bright, red berries developing in fall persist through winter and into early spring. Ideal for group plantings for shrub borders, foundations, natural wildlife areas, along with low spots or along streams and ponds. Requires male and female plant to produce berries. Note: Due to plant immaturity, gender is unknown and can not be requested or guaranteed.

Fast = Over 24" per year

Mature Height: 6-12' Mature Spread: 6-12'

Growth Rate: Medium

Growing Conditions: Prefers moist, acidic soils. Partial

to full sun. Tolerant of wet, swampy areas.



Growth Rates: Slow = Less than 12" per year Medium = 12-24" per year

POTTED PERENNIALS

Sold individually in I quart pots



AGASTACHE Arizona Sandstone

<u>Description</u>: Also known as hummingbird mint. Compact variety featuring an abundant display of orange, terra cotta colored tubular flowers on dense spike clusters.

Short-lived perennial. Essential addition for a pollinator garden. Attracts bees, butterflies and hummingbirds. Deer and rabbit resistant.

<u>Mature Height</u>: 8-10" <u>Mature Spread</u>: 8-10" <u>Bloom Time:</u> Spring - Late Fall

<u>Growing Conditions</u>: Prefers dry to moist, well-drained soils in full to partial sun. Tolerant of heat, drought and poor soils. Intolerant of poor drainage.



COREOPSIS Double The Sun

<u>Description</u>: Also known as tickseed. Large, semi-double, 2 ½" flowers showcase bright, golden yellow. Hardy,

low-maintenance variety blooms 2-3 weeks earlier than comparable varieties. Attracts bees and butterflies. Deer and rabbit resistant.

Mature Height: 12-15" Mature Spread: 12-15"

Bloom Time: Spring - Late Fall

Growing Conditions: Requires dry, well-drained soil in full sun. Tolerant of

heat and drought.



DELOPSPERMA

Fire Wonder

<u>Description</u>: Bright red and yellow blooms create a dense, spreading ground cover of bold color. Low maintenance succulent attracts bees and butterflies. Great for containers,

hanging baskets, rock gardens, border fronts or slopes. Deer resistant.

Mature Height: 4-6" Mature Spread: 18-24"

Bloom Time: Summer - Fall

Growing Conditions: Requires dry, well-drained soils in full sun. Tolerant of

drought and heat.



DELPHINIUM Delfix Blue

<u>Description</u>: Low growing, compact, bushy mound produces single spurred, rich blue flowers on lacy leaves. Short-lived perennial. Perfect for beds, borders and rock gardens.

Attracts butterflies and hummingbirds. Deer and rabbit resistant.

Mature Height: 12-15"
Mature Spread: 6-8"

Bloom Time: Early Summer - Early Fall

Growing Conditions: Prefers moist, well-drained soil. Partial to full sun.



Prairie Splendor

Description: Bright, 4-6" rose-magenta petals surrounding a dark, orange center cone. Shorter, compact and well-branched variety. Excellent for meadow, native plant garden, naturalized area or partially shaded

woodland garden. Attracts butterflies. Deer resistant.

Mature Height: 12-24" Mature Spread: 12-24"

Bloom Time: Late Spring - Fall

<u>Growing Conditions</u>: Prefers dry to medium, well-drained soil. Partial to full

sun. Tolerant of drought, heat and poor soil.



GAILLARDIA Arizona Apricot

Description: Also known as blanket flower.

Apricot-orange colored petals with golden yellow tips surrounding a gold and green cone. Short-lived perennial. Attracts bees and

butterflies. Deer and rabbit resistant.

Mature Height: 10-12" Mature Spread: 10-12"

Bloom Time: Early Summer - Early Fall

Growing Conditions: Prefers average, medium moisture, well-drained soil.

Tolerant of drought and heat. Intolerant of poor drainage.



LAVENDER Hidcote Blue

Description: Compact, fragrant shrub has deep

violet-purple flowers with gray-green foliage. Very versatile; used for perfumes, oils and medicinal purposes. Attracts bees, butterflies and

hummingbirds. Deer and rabbit resistant.

Mature Height: 12-24"

Mature Spread: 12-24"

Bloom Time: Late Spring - Mid Summer

Growing Conditions: Prefers well-drained, alkaline soil in full sun. Tolerant of

drought. Intolerant of poorly drained soils.



MONARDA

Panorama Red

<u>Description</u>: Also known as bee balm.

Produces eye-catching scarlet red flowers on tall, sturdy

stems. Plants are multi-stemmed and produce an abundance of blooms. Attracts bees, butterflies and hummingbirds. Deer and rabbit resistant.

Mature Height: 30-40" Mature Spread: 12-36"

Bloom Time: Mid Summer - Early Fall

Growing Conditions: Prefers moist, well-drained soil. Partial to full sun.



RUDBECKIA

Cherry Brandy

Description: Also known as Black Eyed Susan. First red rudbeckia hybrid. Contains large, dark-red, velvety daisy flowers surrounding a black center. Extended blooming season. Attracts bees, butterflies and hummingbirds.

Mature Height: 20-24" Mature Spread: 12-18" Bloom Time: Early Summer - Early Fall

Growing Conditions: Prefers average soil conditions and partial to full sun.

ROOT FRU



Crimson Gold

Description: Sold individually.

Medium sized, firm, crisp and juicy fruit bursting with robust, sweet and tart flavor. Long bloom period makes it an excellent pollinizer for other apple varieties. Very productive and has a storage life up to 8 months. Often used for fresh eating, cider, jelly and canning. Scab-resistant.

Requires a compatible pollinator species, such as Fuii.

Mature Height: 15-20'

Ripening Date: Mid - Late September

Growing Conditions: Prefers moist, well-drained soil. Partial to full



APPLE

Fuii

Description: Sold individually.

Sugary, sweet flavor touting a crisp, juicy texture and beautiful, red blushed skin. High yielding, medium to large, firm fruit. Storage life of 5-6 months. Excellent for fresh eating, baking, pies and sauce. Requires a pollinator species, such as Crimson Gold.

Mature Height: 12-16'

Ripening Date: Mid September - Mid October

Growing Conditions: Prefers moist, well-drained soil. Partial to full

sun.



BLACK RASPBERRY Bristol

Description: Sold as a pair.

Known to be the best-tasting black raspberry!

Large, firm, all-purpose fruit used for fresh eating, freezing and baking. Winter hardy. Self-pollinating.

Mature Height: 4-5' Ripening Date: July

Growing Conditions: Prefers moist, well-drained, slightly acidic soils

in partial to full sun. Intolerant of wet soils.



BLUEBERRIES

Blueray & Bluecrop

Description: Sold as a pair, one of each variety.

Blueray produces large yields of extra-large, light-blue berries that won't crack. Sweet taste. Bluecrop produces vigorous and consistent light blue berries in large clusters. Firm and somewhat tart. High yielding and extremely hardy. Blueray and Bluecrop are self-pollinating

but yield better if pollinated together. Typically bear fruit within 2-3 years.

Mature Height: 4-6' Ripening Date: July Growing Conditions: Prefers moist, well-drained, organically rich soil in full sun.





DEACH Redhaven

Description: Sold individually.

Vigorous, fast-growing tree produces sweet,

juicy, medium-size, semi-freestone peaches. Almost fuzzless skin allows for ideal fresh eating, canning, baking and freezing. Easy to grow with low maintenance.

Mature Height: 12-15' Ripening Date: August

Growing Conditions: Prefers moist, slightly acidic to neutral, well-

drained soils. Full sun.



RED RASPBERRY

Heritage

Description: Sold as a pair.

Ever bearing raspberry produces large, sweet, dark red berries. Excellent flavor and cold hardy. Produces moderate crops in summer and heavy crops in fall. Self-supporting and hardy. Used for

canning, freezing and jams. Self-pollinating.

Mature Height: 4-5'

Ripening Date: July - September

Growing Conditions: Prefers moist, well-drained, organically rich soil

in full sun.



STRAWBERRY

Albion

Description: Sold 10 per order.

Ever-bearing fruit produces long, conical, sweet, red berries multiple times throughout summer and fall.

Produces high-yielding crops. Perfect dessert strawberry due to high sugar content.

Mature Height: 12" Ripening Date: Late June - Mid Fall

Growing Conditions: Prefers rich, well-drained soils in full sun. Tolerant of heat and humidity.
